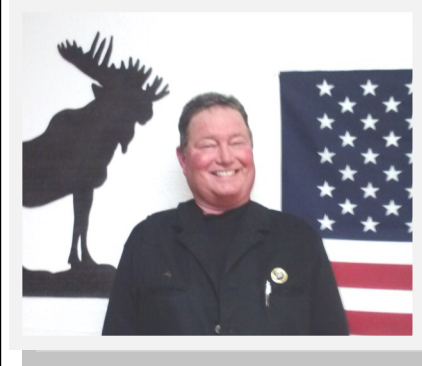

Please check your membership expiration date and renew if you are due! Always have your current membership card with you.

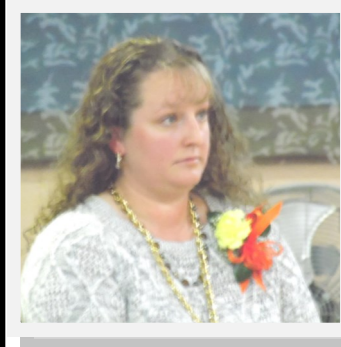
If you have any questions or concerns about anything at the lodge, please come to a membership meeting or leave your name and number with the bartender and I will contact you.

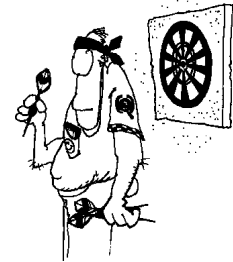

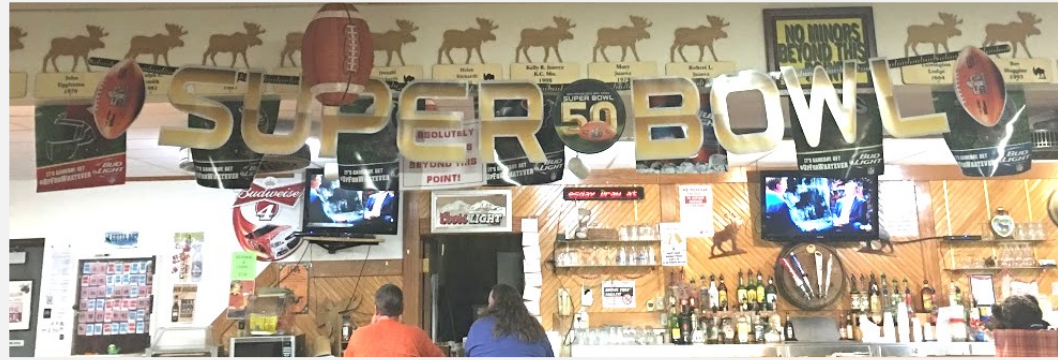

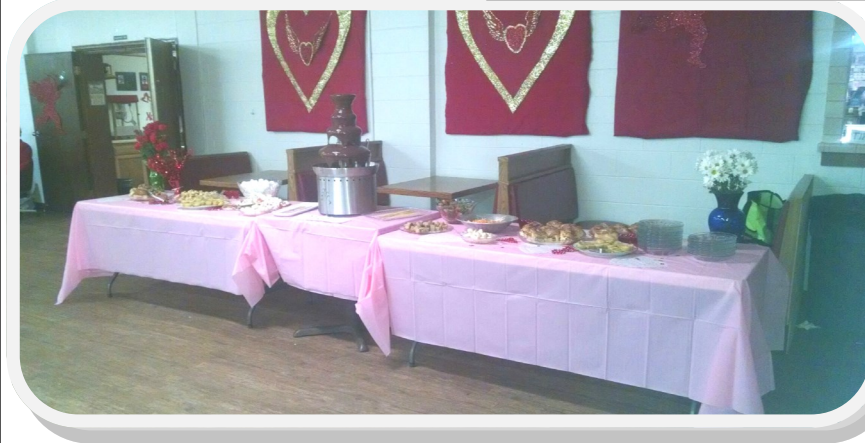
