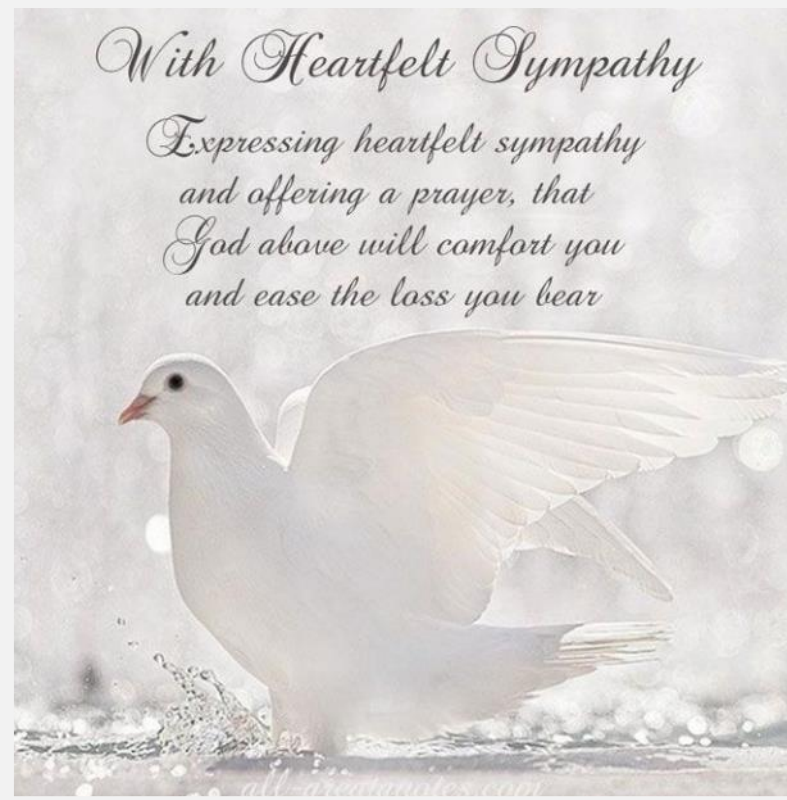

I want to thank Dan Creed for bringing in the brackets for the bathroom partition. They worked out great, Thanks Dan!

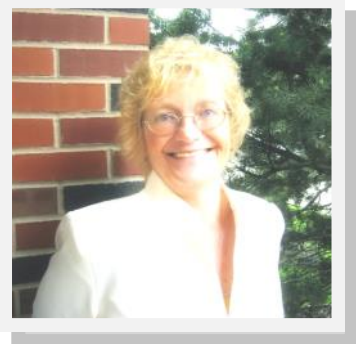
