RECIPES OF THE MONTH

GRILLED HONEY BBQ PORK PACKS



- Ingredients**
- 1/2 cup barbecue sauce
 - 1/4 cup honey
 - 2 teaspoons ground cumin
 - 4 boneless pork ribs or loin chops
 - 2 large ears corn, each cut into 6 pieces
 - 1 cup ready-to-eat baby-cut carrots, cut lengthwise in half
 - 2 cups refrigerated cooked new potato wedges (from 20-oz. bag)
 - 2 medium green onions, sliced (2 tablespoons)

Directions

- Heat gas or charcoal grill. Cut 4 (8x12-inch) sheets of heavy-duty foil; spray with cooking spray. In a small bowl, mix barbecue sauce, honey and cumin. Place 1 pork chop, 3 pieces corn, 1/4 cup carrots and 1/2 cup potato wedges on center of each foil sheet. Spoon 3 tablespoons sauce mixture over pork and vegetables on each sheet.
- Bring up 2 sides of foil so edges meet. Seal edges, making tight 1/2-inch fold; fold again, allowing space for heat circulation and expansion. Fold other sides to seal.
- Place packets on grill. Cover grill; cook over medium-low heat 15 to 20 minutes until pork is no longer pink and meat thermometer inserted in center reads 160 degrees F. To serve, cut large X across top of each packet; carefully fold back foil to allow steam to escape.

TRIPLE-STRAWERRY DESSERT



- Ingredients**
- 1 cup boiling water
 - 1 box (4 serving size) wild strawberry-flavored gelatin
 - 2/3 cup Yoplait 99% Fat Free creamy strawberry or creamy vanilla yogurt (from 2-lb container)
 - 3 cups Kix cereal
 - 1/4 cup butter or margarine, melted

- 1 1/2 cups sliced fresh strawberries
- 9 fresh strawberries, sliced into fans

Directions

- In medium bowl, pour boiling water on gelatin; stir until gelatin is dissolved. Stir in yogurt until melted and smooth. Cover; refrigerate about 1 hour 30 minutes or until thickened but not set.
- Meanwhile, heat oven to 350 degrees F. Place cereal in food storage plastic bag; crush with rolling pin to make 1 cup. In small bowl, stir cereal and butter until well mixed. Press mixture firmly in bottom of ungreased 8-inch square pan. Bake 10 minutes or until crust is light golden brown. Set aside to cool.
- Beat gelatin mixture with electric mixer on high speed 7 to 8 minutes or until doubled in volume. Fold in sliced strawberries; pour over crust. Cover; refrigerate about 1 hour or until firm.
- To serve, cut dessert into squares. Garnish each serving with strawberry fan.
